

APPLYING FOR SISTEM

The application period will open **January 9, 2018** and applications will be accepted until **January 29, 2018**.

In order to apply for SISTEM, the applicant must be a high school student in Southern Nevada. Students should be committed to attending all the sessions.

Applicants will be chosen through a **competitive selection** based on their application. If accepted into the SISTEM program for Fall of 2017, you will be notified by **February 7, 2018**.

Students who are successful in attending **every session** will receive a **certificate of completion** of the SISTEM program. Every time the student attends a session, their name will be put into a drawing for a prize that will be given out at the end of the program.

Transportation is the responsibility of the student. If transportation is an issue, SISTEM will assist students as much as possible in obtaining transportation.
